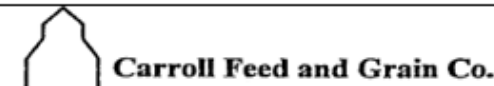

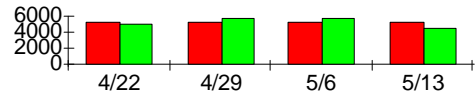

I will be gone starting Monday, May 21 through Monday, May 28 (Memorial Day). Throughout the week, Father Paul will be visiting from Kenya. Each year we have a missionary come for a weekend to raise awareness of the needs of people in other parts of the world. It is also an opportunity to give some of our money to help others. I think the annual missionary visit is great because it makes us look at the world outside of our local community and it reminds us that we are so very connected to people in other parts of the world, especially through our faith. Do what you can to make Fr. Paul feel welcome throughout the week.

Following Memorial Day will be Vacation Bible School for our 3-5 year old kids. This will take place Tuesday through Thursday (May 29-31) at 6:30pm each evening.
