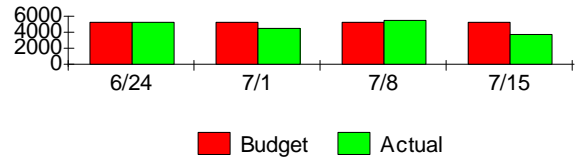

*From the Pastor’s Desk*

I wrote this article two years ago but I feel like it captures the spirit of our Food Stand well:  
 St. Mary’s Food Stand at the Wayne County Fair has a long history. This summer marks its 57<sup>th</sup> anniversary. It is amazing to think that members of our parish have been serving people at the fair since 1955.

The challenge of the food stand is to continue this service. It requires a good number of volunteers. Year after year people continue to step up and help. With your cooperation, that will continue this year.

You may not have ever noticed a plaque in Holy Family Hall given to the St. Mary’s Food Stand in 2005 by the Wayne County Agricultural Society in honor of the stand’s 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary. It is an entertaining and poet history of the stand. It reads:

The Food Stand under “the old grandstand” was leaky and not very clean / Plus, some other infractions and “varmints” food inspectors had seen! / So the men of St. Mary’s decided that they’d erect St. Mary’s Food Tent. / But the sun at fair time convinced them this was “purty” steep rent. / Volunteers of St. Mary’s aren’t people that are inclined to shirk! / But their talents for erection of tents was not their line of work / So they made a deal with the Fair Board that has proved well planned / If the Fair would provide space and material, they’d build a Food Stand / Fairgoers soon found St. Mary’s Food Stand, but the flies found it too!!! / If you didn’t enjoy flies with your sandwich, the flies had to shoo!!! / To maintain St. Mary’s standard of fine eating, it’s readily seen / The volunteer builders would have to enclose it with screen. / Their plans were never “half baked”, everything was done up “brown” / So if you’re hot, tired, and hungry, head for St. Mary’s, and “sit down and cheer” / The Wayne County Fair is much better because St. Mary’s Food Stand is here!!!
