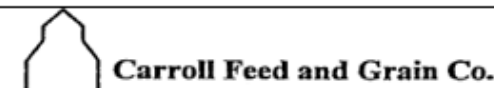

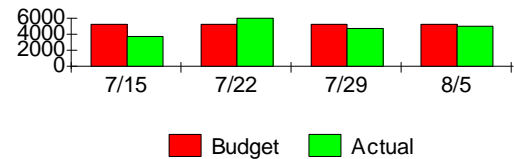

*From the Pastor's Desk*

There are a few things I want to let you know about: Last Saturday morning I woke up and fire trucks were at our school. Don't worry! There was not a fire. That morning there had been very strong thunder and lightning which set off our school's fire alarm. The lightning fried the fire alarm system and part of our parish phone system. Neither of these are major problems. We are working with our insurance company to either fix or replace the fire alarm system and with our phone company to get all of our phone lines up and running again. Unrelated to the lightning, with the help of American Broadband, we are getting fiber optic internet run into the school and parish office. This will add to our internet capabilities and set us up for future technology changes. With all of this, I want to thank Ray Nelson, Dustin Ankeny, Tim Garvin, Kirk Hochstein, Gail and Roger Hochstein, Patty Wurdeman and others who have helped.

One desire I have for this coming school year and the upcoming Year of Faith (October 2012 to November 2013) is to give adults more ways to grow in their faith. On Wednesday nights, while the kids of the parish are in their Religious Education classes, I would like to invite any and all adults in the parish to meet in the church for some adult faith formation. I do not have a definite plan for these evenings yet, but I envision time for prayer, a short presentation, discussion on the topic, and ending in prayer. Our high school group (WINGS) may be involved in these evenings too, but with their own group for discussion. Pray with me that Religious Education parents and others will take advantage of this opportunity and that it will bear fruit for God.

After the Masses this weekend, I will make novenas for students to St. Thomas Aquinas available for those who are interested. With our community being so connected to education, it is important for us to pray for students and educators. Start the novena this Sunday (August 12) to finish on the first day of classes at WSC. Start on Tuesday (August 14) to conclude on the first day of school for all the kids in town.
