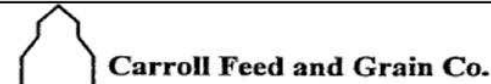

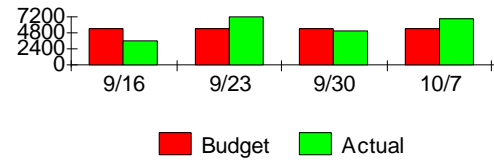

From the Pastor’s Desk

October is Breast Cancer Awareness Month. Over the last several years, efforts during this month to increase awareness when it comes to breast cancer have grown and grown. From fundraising events to athletes wearing pink on their uniforms, it is almost as if everywhere we look there is a reminder of breast cancer, its victims, and what we can do to fight it.

Personally, my mother is a breast cancer survivor. I ran a marathon in 2000 and raised money for breast cancer research. We need to do everything we can to raise awareness and help in finding a cure to all forms of cancer. I do not know too many people who have not been impacted in some way by cancer. Almost everyone has had a friend, coworker, family member, or someone they know in the community who has dealt with cancer in their lives.

I do have one warning. There are a lot of great organizations trying to fight cancer, but not all of them are in line with our Catholic beliefs. For example, many cancer-fighting organizations contribute to Planned Parenthood (by far the nation’s biggest abortion provider) and to embryonic stem cell research (which destroys human embryos—human lives). For example, Susan G. Komen for the Cure, which hosts races all over the country to raise money for breast cancer research, gives a good amount of the money that they raise to Planned Parenthood. In 2009-2010 Susan G. Komen for the Cure gave over \$600,000 to Planned Parenthood affiliates.

So while we need to help with the fight against breast cancer and other forms of cancer, we also need to do some research on the organizations before we give them money. For me, when I am asked to help contribute to any charitable organization I call that organization and ask if they contribute to Planned Parenthood or to embryonic stem cell research. If you are looking for a great organization in Nebraska, the Nebraska Coalition for Ethical Research promotes efforts to cure diseases without endangering human lives to do it. May cancer be defeated and ethical ways!

Mary, Mother of God, pray for us.
