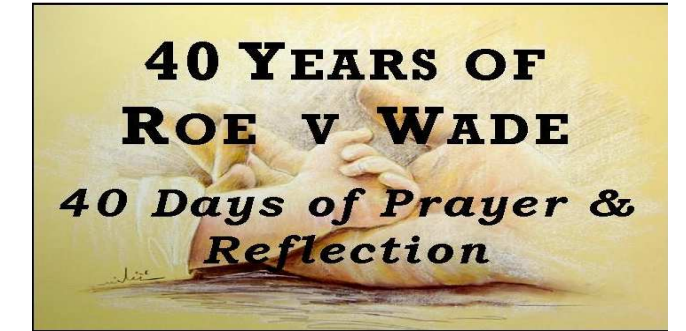
WHERE FAITH AND KNOWLEDGE MEET
