

From the Pastor's Desk

With Holy Week upon us, I really want to encourage all of us to enter into this holiest of weeks with all of our hearts. The more you dive into the great events of Holy Week, the more you will know the meaning and power of Jesus' death and resurrection.

Chrism Mass: This Mass takes place at Saint Cecilia Cathedral in Omaha on Monday morning. Almost all of our Confirmation students will journey to this Mass along with the priests of the Archdiocese of Omaha. What is special about this Mass is that the oils of catechumenate, the sick, and the sacred chrism are blessed. The oils are used for the next year at every Baptism, Confirmation, Anointing of the Sick, and Ordination. Also, at this Mass, the priests renew their vows. Please pray for our Confirmation students and the priests on Monday.

Holy Thursday: On Thursday at 7pm is the Mass of the Lord's Supper. This is the commemoration of the Last Supper in which Jesus gave us the gift of His real presence under the Eucharist. At this Mass, I will wash the feet of 12 people in remembrance of Jesus washing the feet of the 12 apostles. It concludes with a procession of the Eucharist to Holy Family Hall where people can come and pray in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament until midnight. This is the final Mass before the Easter Vigil.

Good Friday: We have a number of events on Good Friday which are all centered on the Cross of Jesus. This is the day when Jesus gave His life for the forgiveness of our sins. At noon is a community Stations of the Cross starting at 7th and Main and going to the Presbyterian Church. At 3pm will be a Catholic Stations of the Cross in our church. 3pm is the hour when Jesus died. At 7pm will be our Good Friday Service when we once again hear the Passion and venerate the Cross of Christ.

All of this leads to the celebration of Easter with the Easter Vigil at 8:30pm on Saturday night and Easter morning Masses at 8 and 10am.

For me, Holy Week is my favorite week of the year. It makes the events of Jesus' death and resurrection really come alive. I pray that all of us may enter into this week as much as possible and thereby be more conformed to Christ.

Mary, patroness of our parish, pray for us.


