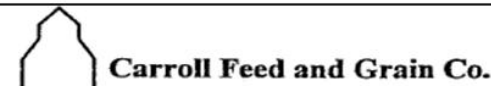

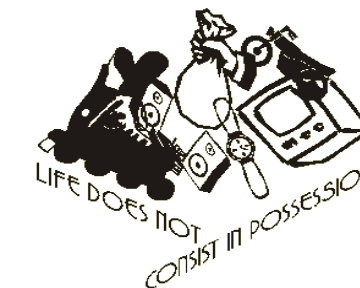

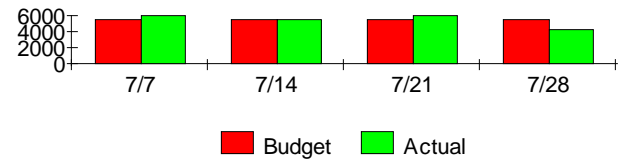

*From the Pastor’s Desk*

I continue my reflections of Pope Francis’ first encyclical, “The Light of Faith”.

In paragraph 13, our Holy Father looks at the opposite of faith, which is idolatry. Like when Moses was on Mount Sinai receiving the Ten Commandments and the people of Israel made a molten calf, when we can’t bear God’s hiddenness we instead turn to things we are more comfortable with. For the people of Israel, it was the image of a calf. For us today, we can turn to TV, the internet, money, fame, relationships, sex, pornography, alcohol or any of a million other things as our “idols”.

When we turn away from God and toward these idols, we find ourselves on a path that leads to nowhere. We find ourselves following the latest trend, our current desire, or falling into our latest addiction. Isn’t this happening more and more in our country? Instead of turning to God with our hearts, we turn to technology, substances like alcohol, or something else to fill us. When we are turning to things that are not God, we find ourselves being empty. This is seen today in the high rate of depression in our country, even though we are the richest country in the world.

“Those who choose not to put their trust in God must hear the din of countless idols crying out: ‘Put your trust in me!’ Faith...breaks with idols to turn to the living God in a personal encounter. Believing means entrusting oneself to a merciful love which always accepts and pardons, which sustains and directs our lives...Here in lies the paradox: by constantly turning towards the Lord, we discover a sure path which liberates us from the dissolution imposed upon us by idols.”

I see this in my life. When I am lonely, sad, feel unappreciated, or whatever, I have a choice. I can turn to God in prayer and trust and thereby face this emptiness with faith. The alternative is for me to run away from that emptiness. Instead of letting God fill me up, I can choose to turn to TV or something else (too much). More and more, I find myself going next door to the church to open my heart to God. When I do that, I find that God really does help me.

In faith, may we turn away from our idols that only lead to emptiness and turn towards God.

Mary, Mother of God, pray for us.
