**SACRAMENT OF THE SICK:** Celebrated individually upon request. If someone is seriously ill, please call the rectory.

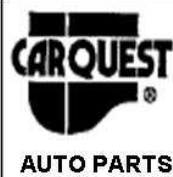

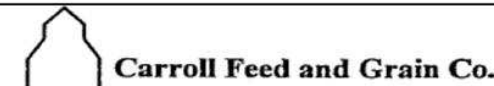

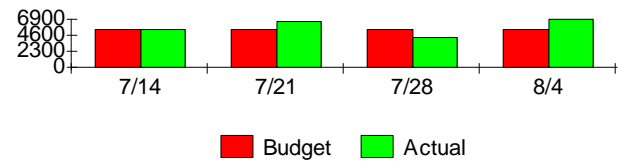

*From the Pastor’s Desk*

Along with many or all of you, I have realized that the school year is arriving this week. We are a community which centers on education. I ask you to pray for all of the teachers, professors, students, and families in our community. God has many graces in store for this school year. May all of us have hearts fully open to those graces. There will also be many temptations that will attack our young people. As we say in the Our Father, “lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil”. We need to pray.

Here are two prayer ideas for you:

**1. Novena to St. Thomas Aquinas, patron saint of students.** I have made several copies and they are in the entryway of the church. Each day, for nine days, pray the daily reflection and the novena prayer.

**2. Pray the Novena Prayer to St. Thomas Aquinas.** If you did not grab a copy of the entire novena, you can say the novena prayer for nine days. Here is it:

“St. Thomas Aquinas, patron of students and Catholic schools, I thank God for the gifts of light and knowledge he bestowed on you, which you used to build up the Church in love. I thank God, too, for the wealth and richness of theological teaching you left in your writings. Not only were you a great teacher, you lived a life of virtue and you made holiness the desire of your heart. If I cannot imitate you in the brilliance of your academic pursuits, I can follow you in the humility and charity which marked your life. As St. Paul said, charity is the greatest gift, and it is open to all. Pray for me that I might grow in holiness and charity. Pray also for Catholic schools, and for all students. In particular, please obtain the favor I ask during this novena (mention your request). Amen.”

You can offer your novena for a particular student or teacher, for the FOCUS missionaries and WSC Catholic Ministry, for St. Mary’s School, for our public schools, or for yourself.

May our prayers help this school year be a time when students don’t just grow intellectually, but also grow in their relationship with Jesus and the Church.
