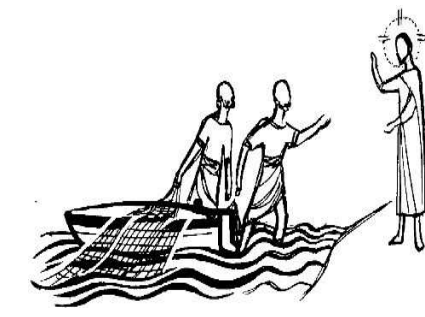

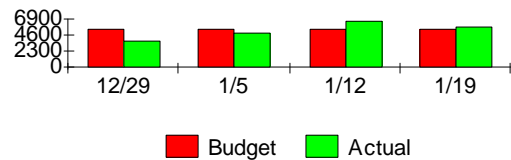

*From the Pastor’s Desk*

Over the next few weeks, I will go into more detail about the Ignite the Faith Campaign goals. My desire is for people to have a good understanding about where their money will be going and why the campaign is so important.

The Priest Retirement Fund is a big part of the campaign. Why is that? Here are some questions and answers as to why it is in this campaign.

The goal is to fully fund The Priest Pension Plan by raising \$6,000,000. Thirty-five priests are expected to retire in the next ten years. This represents 25% of all active priests in the archdiocese. The Priest Pension Plan helps provide a dignified retirement for our priests who have spent their lives in service to God. These additional funds from the campaign will ensure that we meet our ongoing obligation to our current and future priests.

Who is Covered by the Priest Pension Plan? The Plan covers only priests who have been incardinated into the Archdiocese of Omaha. Religious order priests receive retirement benefits from their religious community.

Who oversees the Priest Pension Plan? The Plan is governed by a Board of Trustees appointed by Archbishop Lucas and comprised of priests and lay experts.

How much is in the fund? \$11,131,000 as of Dec 31, 2012

How much do parishes contribute to the fund? \$4,300 per year for each full-time priest

Why is it not fully funded? There are three main factors that led to the plan being less than fully funded: 1.Priests are living longer. 2.Conservative parish assessments. 3.Lower-than-projected return on investments during the recent economic downturn.

What are the specific benefits provided by the plan? Priests receive \$15,900 annually. The plan also pays \$1,260 annually to provide Medicare Part B coverage.

Once we add \$6 million, will the plan be “fully funded?” Yes, according to current projections. Future funding levels will depend on the interest generated by investments, the benefits paid to priests and the assessments paid by parishes.

Do priests pay in to social security? Yes, the I.R.S. classifies priests as “self-employed” when it comes to social security tax. Therefore our priests pay their own social security.

Mary, Mother of God, pray for us and for our retired priests.
