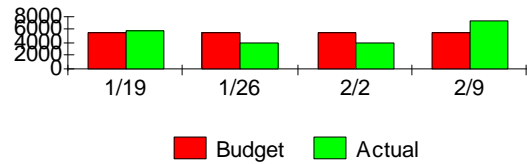

From the Pastor’s Desk

Continuing a series of articles on the “Ignite the Faith” Campaign, I will let you know of some other ways our parish will benefit. While we our attitude should never be solely, “What is in it for me?” it is still beneficial to see all the ways this Archdiocesan campaign will help your parish.

Next school year (2014-2015), we will be a pilot program for a new high school youth program called YDisciple. I think all of us know how many obstacles there are for our young people when it comes to faith. If we want future generations of Catholics to embrace the faith, we need to help our youth. YDisciple will help us do that. Our WINGS high school group has already started to get ready for this program. It has been developed by the Augustine Institute in Denver to help our young people truly embrace the faith and live it out in their daily lives. It centers on small groups and short video presentations. In the last few years, the WINGS group has grown from 8-10 kids each Wednesday to between 25-30 kids each week. Amy Woerdemann and Jean Loberg have a lot to do with that, along with the help of some energetic and faith-filled WSC students. Our prayer and hope is that YDisciple will help WINGS continue to grow and be fruit.

The teachers of St. Mary’s School will benefit from a program called “School of Faith”. Starting in the 2025-2016 school year, they will have monthly in-service workshops on how to grow in their faith and share it better with our kids and families. As the saying goes, “You can’t give what you don’t have”. Our teachers have a fire for the faith already, but our desire is for that fire to burn in their hearts even more and spread to our kids through their religion classes and spiritual opportunities.

The campaign is called “Ignite the Faith” for a reason. YDisciple and School of Faith are two efforts to help form and renew our young people and teachers in the faith. I pray that these efforts will truly “ignite the faith” here in our parish and throughout the Archdiocese of Omaha.

Mary, Mother of God, pray for us. St. Cecilia, patron of our Archdiocese, pray for us.

WHERE FAITH AND KNOWLEDGE MEET

If you have questions about preparing your child for, and entering kindergarten for the 2014-2015 school year, I recommend visiting the Nebraska Department of Education’s website at: education.ne.gov and reading the booklet entitled, “Ready for Success.” (Go to the website and type Ready for Success in the search bar.) The brochure answers some commonly asked questions parents have such as: “What does school readiness mean? When can my child start kindergarten? How do I know if my child is ready? How can I support my child’s education?” Under “How can I support my child’s education?” is a bullet entitled: “Ask about your child’s day and about the work he brings home, too.” This is true for every student – not just for kindergarten students. Please try to avoid questions that can be easily answered with one-word responses. Instead of asking, “How was school?” Try, “Tell me about the best thing you did at school.” Or, “What was the hardest thing you had to do today (in reading/math)?” “Tell me about the book(s) read in class today.” If your child will be entering kindergarten next school year, please plan to attend the Kindergarten Round-Up at St. Mary’s School on Friday, March 14, 2014, from 8:30-10:00 a.m. If your child will be entering Pre-K, our Pre-K Open House is on Friday, March 7, 2014 from 8:30 to 10:00 a.m.
