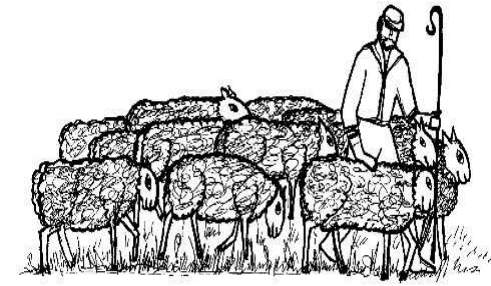

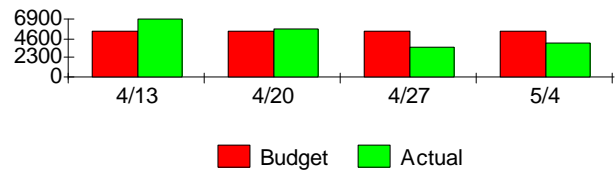

News and Notes from the Pastor’s Desk

I need to say “thank you” to everyone for being a part of the Ignite the Faith Commitment Weekend. While filling out intention cards and hearing about a campaign are not fun or glamorous, everyone seemed to be very understanding and supportive.

To give you some rough estimates, we got over \$59,000 in new pledges to the campaign. Some people were not able to finalize their commitment at the Masses, so we expect some other pledges to come in within the next few weeks. Just as important, we were able to get a lot more families involved. For me, getting people involve, no matter what their gift would be, and is very important. We got a lot of pledges to pray for the campaign too, which is vital to anything we do as a parish. Thank you for your commitments.

This week we have already started to receive money back to the parish from the campaign. Whatever money comes in, the parish portion comes back to us each quarter. So we have already gotten \$3,123.50 for the church and \$12,494 for the school project.

I announced at those Masses that I am getting a second six-year term as the Pastor of St. Mary’s. After all of the Masses and all throughout this week, more than a few people have expressed how happy they are about that. It has been very encouraging. I know I have made more than a few mistakes in the last six years and I will make different mistakes in the coming years too. When my mistakes or sinfulness impact you or your family, please forgive me. I hope and pray that even my downfalls come from an attempt to do what God wants and out of trying to do what is best for all the families of the parish.

At the Masses, I also said I would attempt to walk to all of the communities our parish serves that do not have Catholic churches (Carroll, Wakefield and Winside). My plan is to do these three walks in June. Right now I am tentatively planning to do the walks on the morning of Monday, June 2nd, the morning of Saturday, June 14th, and the afternoon/evening of Sunday, June 22nd. I will let people know when those times and dates get firm. I am more than open to having people walk and pray with me. The past week or two, I have already started training. I am excited about it!
