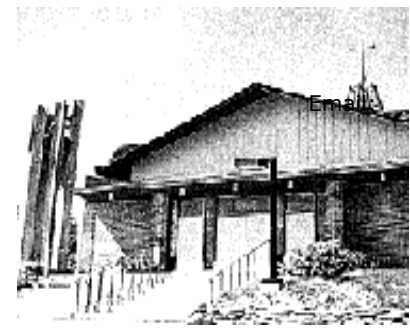

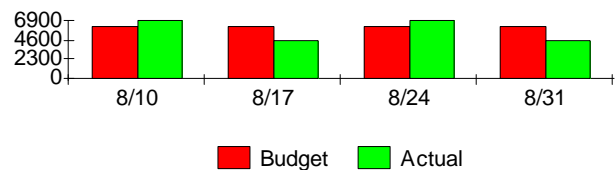

News and Notes from the Pastor’s Desk

A few weeks ago, I challenged us to grow in our knowledge of the Catholic faith. With that in mind, this article is an edition of: “Why do Catholics do that?”

Do Catholics worship Mary?

Have you ever been asked this question by a non-Catholic? I have been asked this question more than a few times. I think the confusion comes because people fail to know the difference between “honoring” and “worshiping”. We honor Mary, we do not worship her. Worship is the devotion we only give to God. In the first of the Ten Commandments we are called to worship only God. So do we worship Mary? Absolutely not!

At the same time, Christians have always had a deep devotion to Mary. This devotion is meant to honor the special role Mary played in the life of Jesus, her deep faith in God, and her motherly care and prayers for us in heaven. Think of it this way, when a family member or friend who we admired dies, we rightly honor their memory by keeping a picture to them or in some other way. In fact, our country has a holiday honoring those who have died in its service, Memorial Day. We honor these people for their character and what they have meant to us. The same is true of Mary, who honor her unique role in the salvation won for us by Jesus.

The same is true of all the saints. We honor them as examples of Christian living and we ask them to pray for us in heaven. We do not worship them.

We can pray to Mary and the saints because they are alive in heaven. Since they are alive, we can ask them to pray for us or speak to them the way we would talk to someone alive on earth.

If you are asked this question, the easy response could be: “We honor Mary. We do not worship her.” If you want to use a passage from the Bible, even Mary says, “From this day, all generations will call me blessed” (Luke 1:48). Isn’t Mary saying that everyone in the future will honor her? That is exactly what we do.

Mary, Mother of God, pray for us.
