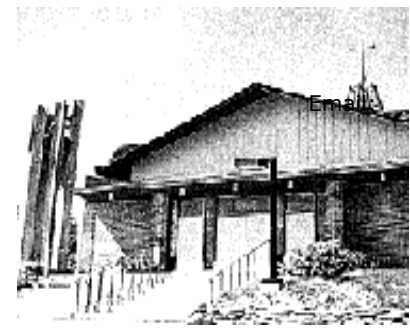

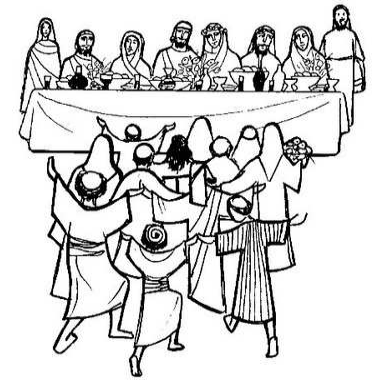

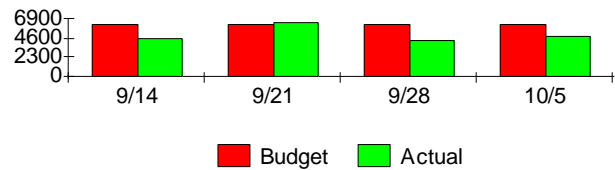

**Why School Choice**

Wealthy families who wish to have a religious education for their children or who are dissatisfied with the quality, perceived or real, of their public school, have a greater ability to enroll their children in private or alternative schools than do more marginalized families. Our country is experiencing a reality where wealth creates educational opportunity, and a lack of wealth limits the opportunity. Coupling this fact with the realization that minority and poor students experience greater academic achievement gaps than their white and wealthier peers, a social injustice issue becomes evident. Twenty-three states and the District of Columbia have responded to this injustice by affording American families the financial means to choose the type of school in which to educate their children, a reality known today as school choice.
