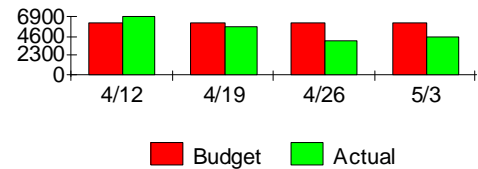

News and Notes from the Pastor’s Desk

Last Sunday, I spoke about how I will be leaving in the summer of 2016. I have some goals for the coming year. I will need your help to accomplish these.

1. We have a lot of programs for kids to grow in their faith. How about adults? With our family-based Religious Education program, we have started going in this direction. However, we need to do more. If our faith isn’t growing, it tends to die. Plus, when adults are alive in their faith, children tend to embrace the faith too. I do not know what this will look like at this point, but helping adults form a deep relationship with Jesus and grow in that relationship daily is needed. Forming small groups of adults to support each other spiritually, emotionally, and physically would have to be a part of this too. These small groups would connect us to each other more and help us stay connected to God and the Church.

2. Our parish is blessed to have a good number of talented cantors and musicians. The problem is that more and more we have had Masses that were not supported by musicians. The problem is not the cantors and musicians we have. The problem is our need for more of them. Also, they need to be more supported. While our worship is centered on the Word of God and the Eucharist, music helps to foster a prayerful environment. Music has a great way of instantly uniting people. All of a sudden, our individual voices become one united voice. Like with adult faith formation, I am not sure what this will look like practically. Saint Cecilia, patroness of church music, pray for us.

3. The first two goals were for the parish, but this last goal is for me. I want to make the next priest’s life more manageable than mine. I am not complaining, because I enjoy all the things I am a part of. I only have myself to blame for my schedule being the way it is. With parish responsibilities during the day and activities for the college students at night, it can make for long days. The priest who replaces me will still be involved in both parish and campus life, but I want to do what I can to make sure he gets a day off each week, is able to take time to exercise, and see his family/friends on a regular basis.

If you can think of other goals we should have for our parish, be sure to let me or a member of our Parish Pastoral Council know.

Mary, Mother of God and our patroness, pray for us.
