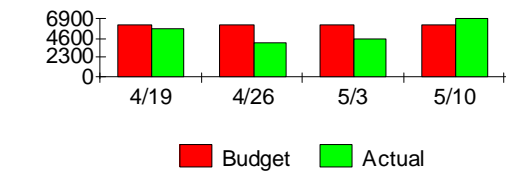

News and Notes from the Pastor's Desk

Schools get out soon and graduations are upon us. This means that many students and adults will start a different routine for the summer.

Summer is a great time to get out of your normal routine a little bit. For students this means getting out of school. For adults this could mean taking some time off of work. I know I am looking forward to some time away this summer.

Summer can bring temptations too. I remember a child telling me about his family's "vacation rule". This rule was used as an excuse not to go to Mass while on vacation. What this says to our kids is, "Mass is not that important". It also says to God, "I'm on vacation so I don't need You this week". I definitely see the temptation, but we have to be careful of the message we are giving to our kids and ourselves. [Note: If you miss Mass out of negligence or laziness, you should go to Confession before receiving communion again.]

Summer sports can also be an obstacle to faith. I love sports and would never discourage them, but sometimes sports can dominate the lives of our young people. If a sport is taking up so much time that you are not praying, not able to attend church summer programs like Totus Tuus, or not attending Sunday Mass, something is out of whack.

Another thing to consider in the warmer months is our attire for Mass. While I am not saying everyone should attend Sunday Mass in a suit and tie, what we wear does reflect how important it is to us. What does our clothing say about the importance of Church and God in our lives? The altar servers know my feelings about flip-flops at Mass. What we wear says something. If God and Mass are important to us, then what we wear should reflect that. I should also point out that judging people by what they wear to church is never a Christian thing to do. I want us to consider what we wear, but do not worry about what others wear.

Have a great summer, hopefully get out of your routine a bit, and continually grow closer to God.
