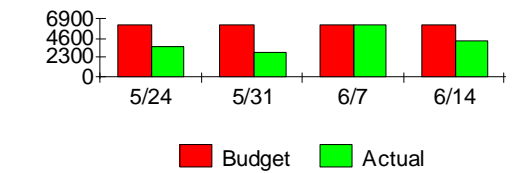

News and Notes from the Pastor’s Desk

--Pope Francis released an encyclical letter on the environment this week. So you know, an encyclical is a letter, usually treating some aspect of Catholic doctrine, sent by the Pope and addressed either to the Catholic bishops or the world. You may have heard about this latest encyclical in the news. The problem with news accounts is that they tend to pick the parts of the document that fit their biases. This is why news accounts are often over-reactions or sensationalized. Especially with a topic like the environment, it can’t be summed up in an attention-grabbing headline. So, I have a suggestion. If you want to know what Pope Francis really wrote about the environment, read the document itself. It can be found on the Vatican website (along with all Church documents) at www.vatican.va. Personally, I am planning to read it over the next few weeks.

--When you come for Mass, you may notice that there is some work being done on our school building. Thanks to your generosity last year with the “Ignite the Faith” Campaign, our school is getting an updated electrical system and air conditioning. These improvements are much needed. The building’s electrical system dated back to when the school was built in 1953. Needless to say, the school could not handle the demands of modern technology. Adding air conditioning was a nice bonus. In case you are wondering, every three months the parish continues to get 40% of what people have given to the campaign back for this school project and 10% for a future parish project. The Archdiocese has been really good about ensuring that whatever money from the campaign comes in to them immediately goes to its intended purpose.

--In other news, Mr. Mark Evetovich resigned as the Head Teacher of St. Mary’s School to become the principal of Walthill High School. While I am very sad that Mr. E is leaving, he will be a great addition to the Walthill school system. Last week, one of our current teachers, Mrs. Jilliane Allemann, was hired as the new Head Teacher (aka. “Teacher Facilitator”). Our school has grown from 17 kids in 2008 to about 40 kids for the 2015-2016 school year. The staff of the school has been the number one reason for that growth, along with families seeing the value of a great faith-based education.

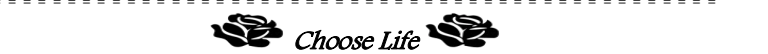
