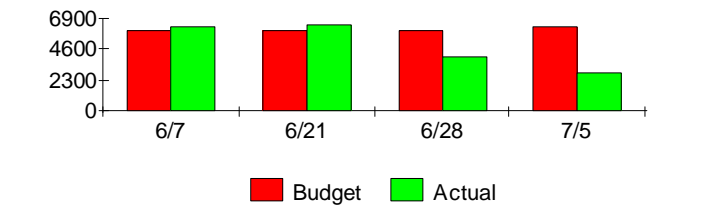

Campaign Funds Returned to Rural Schools and Religious Education Programs

It is not unusual to see a flurry of maintenance projects and building improvements in our schools in the summer time, but with the 40% rebate our rural schools and religious education programs will receive from the *Ignite the Faith* Campaign, our rural schools are seizing the opportunity to invest in their infrastructure. St. Leonard School in Madison reported that they have made much needed repairs to the north door of the school and have purchased a new photocopier. Guardian Angels Central Catholic in West Point have used part of their rebate to rewire GACC and Activity Center with a faster wireless internet hub. Troy Berryman, president of Norfolk Catholic Schools, said *Ignite the Faith* made it possible for them to expand their pre-school program for their youngest learners through the addition of a teacher, a classroom and playground upgrades. Thanks to donors all across the archdiocese many initiatives are coming to fruition!

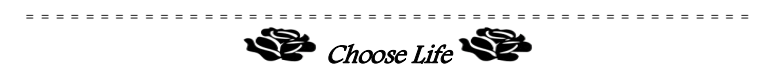
