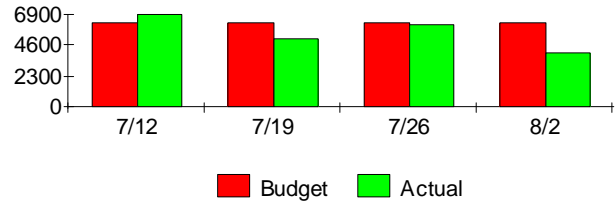

News and Notes from the Pastor’s Desk

I hope everyone continued to pray for the person they greeted before Mass last weekend. I have been praying for Madelyn, Sally, and Nancy (one for each weekend Mass) this week. The goal is for all of us to be more spiritually connected at Mass and throughout the week. In a few weeks, we will have a few thousand college students come to our community. Many of them will be starting college and their faith will be tested in numerous ways. My prayer is that we can support each other and the college students by praying for each other more intentionally. I look forward to seeing what graces might come our way. We should never underestimate the power of prayer.

We are adding something to our Family Formation Program (for our families with kids in K-6 grades). Parents have told us that they desire more than just the Family Class Night on the first Wednesday of each month. In response, the parish will offer a “Family Activity Night” on the third Wednesday of the month. I will plan a large-group activity for our parents and kids together (anyone is welcome to attend). The goal is to grow in our faith but not in a classroom setting. This would be a faith experience rather than a class. Some activities may be a “kids versus adults” trivia night, prayer experiences like Adoration or the Stations of the Cross, or some kind of service opportunity. The families will still be given home lessons to do throughout the month, but this event each month will be another chance for families to grow together in faith.

To get ready for the new school year, the parish is looking for adults to help with our Religious Education Program. For teachers of K-6 grades, it would entail one class night (the first Wednesday of the month) and one “Teacher Night” (the second Wednesday of the month) each month. All of our kids that are in 7th grade or higher meet weekly. If you interested in helping the next generation of Catholics to grow in their faith, give the office a call.
