**COLLEGE STUDENTS & VISITORS:** We welcome you and pray you will feel at home worshipping with us.

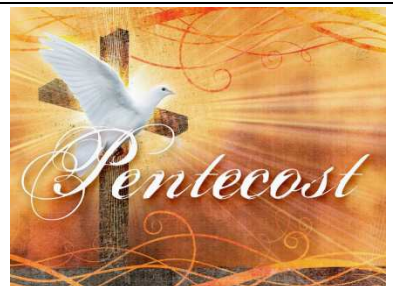

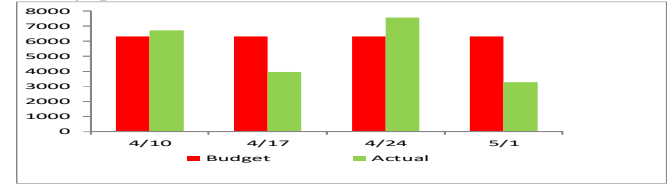

*News and Notes from the Pastor's Desk*

May 1<sup>st</sup> made me realize that I am in my last two months at St. Mary's. To be honest, it does not seem real yet. With this in mind, I thought about writing about some of the highlights of the last 8 years. So, over the next two months, I will be writing about some of these memories.

In June 2011, we did a good amount of work on the church. If you remember, the carpet had been original to when the church was built in 1970. The old carpet was not attached to the floor in spots and was not a pretty shade of green. We ended up doing a lot more than changing the carpet. Here is what was done: --New tiles were put on the floor in the main entryway of the church. If you look at the floor in the entryway, you may see how the tiles match the pieces of stone that make up portions of the altar.

--The corners with the statues were redone. We brought the statues out a bit and made nice pedestals for them to be on.

--We added stone columns to the wall behind the altar and on the walls with the Stations of the Cross. Once again, these tie into the stone on the altar.

--The pews were re-stained and new kneelers were put on.

Two memories stick out for me. First, when we were taking out the pews in the church, it was gross to find gum underneath the pews. Just a reminder, no gum in church! Second, we had one weekend of Masses down in the hall. It made people uncomfortable because they couldn't sit in their normal spots. We are such creatures of habit!

My hope is that these were not merely physical updates to the church building. I pray that the work that was done brought us closer together as a community. Also, the desire was that a beautiful church would help people to experience Jesus more easily when they come to Mass or to pray.

Mary, Mother of God and our patroness, pray for us.
