## From Your Pastor ~ Fr. Mark Beran



This week, the parish grounds have not felt the same. Something has been missing. We are missing the sound of kids in the school, Religious Education classes, and all of the other school-year activities. We have entered into the summer routine. While it is quieter right now, it is not like this all summer. Two of my favorite events are coming up.

Vacation Bible School will start on Tuesday, May 31st. This is for our 3-5 year olds. For three straight evenings, from 6:30-8pm, the kids have a great time and grow in their faith. There is something about the innocence and openness of these kids. They seem to naturally be able to grasp God's love for them. Through songs, crafts, Bible stories, and snacks, they come to know the faith more deeply. Jesus was right when he took a child and said that, "unless you turn and become like children, you will not enter the kingdom of heaven." (Matthew 18:3)

In the first full week of June (5-10), things get really noisy around here. Totus Tuus ("Totally Yours"—Totally Christ's through Mary) will be for all of our K-12 kids. The K-6 kids will come during the day, Monday through Friday (9am-2:30pm). They will have games, songs, learn about the faith and the mysteries of the Rosary, and have a great time. The week finishes with a water fight and human sundae. The Junior High and High School will meet Sunday through Thursday from 7-9pm. Each night is totally different and has a good mix of prayerful time and fun.

I encourage all of our families to consider these great opportunities for our kids. It is the only time when our kids get to really be submerged in their faith. The goal is to help them know that Jesus is not just someone you experience at Mass on Sunday, but someone who wants us to grow in our relationship with Him all the time.
