From Your Pastor ~ Fr. Mark Beran

With one month left here, I have been more sentimental lately. My desire this week is to be a more humorous.

I remember graduating from high school knowing I was heading to Wayne State College. I was still in Los Angeles helping my family prepare to move to Fremont, but my father was already living in Nebraska. He mailed me a newspaper article. It was all about the Wayne Chicken Show. That was the first time I heard about this annual festival celebrating all things chicken. So there I was, a city boy, reading about this event. I remember thinking something like, "Where am going to college, again?!" The Chicken Show is a great gift to our community and part of the draw is that it is such an unusual event. As an 18 year old in Los Angeles getting ready to move to Nebraska, it was something I had never dared to imagine before.

The kids' collection at the weekend Masses is always a fan favorite. I have seen a little bit of everything. There have been kids run over by other kids, I have gotten hugs, and some kids have gotten so disoriented that they struggled to find their parents afterward. Even last weekend, I had a little boy put his money in the basket and give me one of the most adult handshakes I have ever received. That small thing at Mass has taught me to be ready for whatever might happen.

The St. Mary's Food Stand at the County Fair has always been fun for me. It has been a great way for me to get to know parishioners better and to interact with people from the community. To be honest, I really don't know what else is at the Fair, because I normally spend all my time there at the Stand. While working there, some years I have worn my priest collar and others I haven't (like when it is 110 degrees outside). It never fails that some of the kids in the parish will come into the Stand and not recognize me without my collar. When they realize it is me, they are not sure what to do. They look at me like I am dressed in a clown suit or something.
