## From Your Pastor ~ Fr. Jeff Mollner

**"Teacher, what must I do to inherit eternal life?"** If we had one question to ask Jesus, it would have to be this one. After all, the ultimate goal of our lives is to spend eternity in the Father's all-embracing love. It is easy to get bogged down in our day to day lives. That is not to say that the things we do and the struggles we endure in our everyday lives aren't important. But this weekend's Gospel invites to consider the most important question, "what must we do to make it to heaven?" Our Lord follows up this question by directing us back to the most basic tenants of our faith, and that is that we are called to the love the Lord our God with all our hearts, and our neighbor as ourselves. Even though we have heard these commands many times throughout our lives, careful reflection often reveals to us how hard it is to live this out. It is easy to put other things in front of our relationship with God, it is easy to put off prayer, the reading of Scripture, and sometimes even going to Mass. But if we aren't worshipping God, it simply means that we started worshipping something else. Perhaps it's our money, perhaps it's our free time, or something as simple as our cell phone, or social media accounts. It could be any number of things, and whenever something becomes more important than God in our life, it begins to throw our whole lives out of order. Ultimately it makes it harder to follow the second part of that great commandment. When we lose sight of God in our lives we also begin to lose sight of our neighbor in need. Right worship of God and love of neighbor are never opposed to one another. In fact, Jesus tells us that if we truly want to love our neighbor, and our neighbor includes everyone around us, it begins with our love of God. God is the source of all the love we have in our lives. This week let us reflect on this question, is my love of God and neighbor the most important thing in my life?
