From Your Pastor ~ Fr. Jeff Mollner

One of the most inspiring characters of the New Testament is that of Mary Magdalene. We celebrated her feast day this past Friday. She is known to have traveled with the Apostles following the death of Jesus, she was present at the crucifixion, and is often identified as the woman who was caught in adultery and shown mercy by Jesus. We can say with absolute certainty that she was a woman of tremendous faith and one of the most influential disciples of our Lord Jesus Christ.

Perhaps the story of Mary Magdalene that is most important in the Gospels involves the morning of the Resurrection. Mary Magdalene would be the very first person to see the Resurrected Christ. St. Gregory the Great hailed Mary Magdalene as the best example of Christian perseverance. She sought Jesus after his death, but did not find him immediately. Every instinct and every appeal to rational thought would have told her that he was dead, and he was not coming back. But she yearned to see Him again so deeply that she continued to search, she went to the tomb that morning, and when Jesus called out her name she recognized him and her search was over, she found her heart's desire. I think this is her most important lesson to us.

Sometimes it is very difficult to see Jesus in our everyday lives. We can even begin to believe that he has abandoned us. But deep down we all have that same burning desire to find him. But very often we give up the search. We need to follow Mary's example and not give up hope. Sometimes we have to go to the most desolate places of our lives, much like Mary searching among the tombs, to hear him call out our names. But once he does, like Mary Magdalene, we must be prepared to respond and to follow Him.
