From Your Pastor ~ Fr. Jeff Mollner

This past week the Church celebrated the feast of St. Martha. Martha has always been one of the most interesting figures in the Gospel. Just a few weeks ago we heard the Gospel where Jesus visited her house. Martha became irritated that her sister Mary was not helping with the serving, instead she was spending her time listening at the feet of Jesus. Jesus tells Martha that she is anxious and worried about many things, but she misses the most important thing. She shows up later in the Gospel following the death of her brother Lazarus. We can assume that she took the words of Jesus to heart, because as she greets Jesus she correctly identifies Him as the Christ, the Son of the Living God who has come into the world. Martha came to realize that Jesus had to be the absolute center of her life. We need to discover the same message in our lives as well. We may do all sorts of good works, we may be concerned with serving those in need, we may take care to make sure that we are there for other people. But if Jesus isn't the center of all our work then we are working for something else. It may be our ego, it may be so that we look better in the eyes of others, or because it makes us feel good about ourselves. Jesus reminded Martha, and he reminds us, that when we center all that we do around Him it leads us to a deeper understanding about the real meaning of life and death. In the end we all desire heaven, it makes sense that if we want Jesus to be the reason for our existence in the next life that He would be the reason for our existence in this life as well.

One of the things that I have realized in my first few weeks as Pastor here at St. Mary's is the tremendous amount of time and effort that our parishioners put into making sure that we continue to thrive as a parish. There are so many people who help out in ways that I haven't even discovered yet. I would especially like to thank all those who help with funerals; the serving, the music, the lunches and in so many other ways. I would also like to acknowledge all those who have helped plan, manage, and volunteer at the fair stand at the county fair. It is a great testimony to our parish that we have so many people who are willing to give their time to making these things happen. Thank you.
